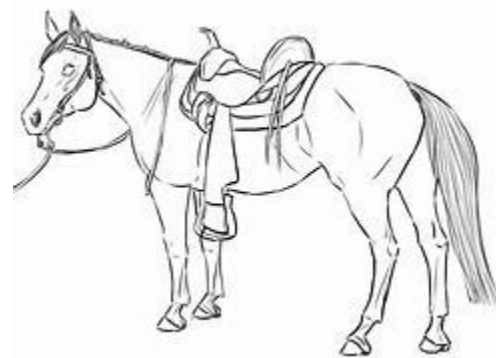

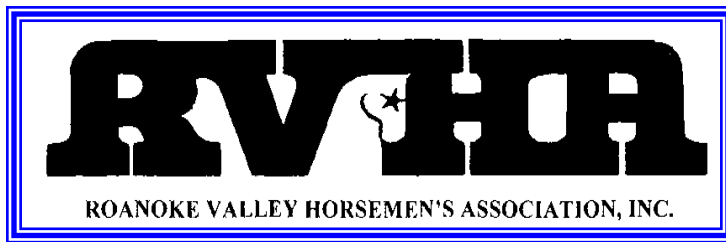

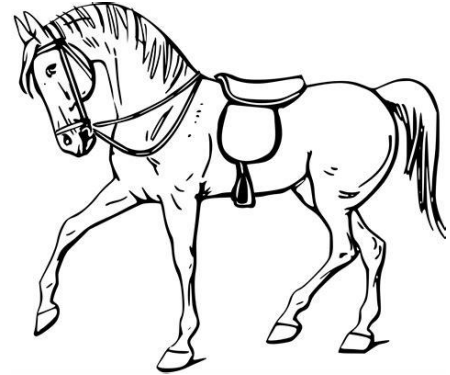

Things to Know

1. Helmet is required in youth games. Protective/safety equipment is not ever penalized in any class.
2. Dogs must be on a leash as required and enforced by Roanoke County Parks and Recreation.
3. Green Hill Park Equestrian Center, Blue Ridge Horse Force, Roanoke Valley Horsemen's Association, Franklin County Equestrian Club, show management, any members, families, organizers, volunteers, property owners, employees assume no responsibility in case of loss, injury or damage to persons, horses or personal property for any cause and admittance and entries are accepted only on this basis.
4. Driving directions: I-81 to exit 137, exit right ½ mile onto Rt. 619 (Wildwood Road). Right at traffic light onto Rt. 11 South (460W & West Main) and go ¾ mile. Turn left onto Rt. 639 (Diuguids Lane) at traffic light. ALL TRAILERS: Entrance 1 mile on right. ALL OTHER TRAFFIC: Entrance 1 ¼ miles on the right.
5. You do not have to be a member of BRHF or FCEC to compete in any class.
6. VA. Department of Agriculture requires all horses on show grounds must have a current (within 12 months) negative Coggins.
7. Stalls are available at \$20/day. Own bedding must be provided and stalls must be cleaned at end of showing.
