All dogs must be on leash at all times.

Awards: Ribbons 1st-6th for each class,
Champion and Reserve Champion for each
division. There will be Year End Awards for
the high scorer in each division. Awards will
be presented at the final Great Beginnings
show in October, and you must be present to
receive your award.

Each show will have a Most Valuable Pony
and Most Valuable Horse, as selected by the
judge.

**TENTATIVE TIME SCHEDULE FOR
JUNE 2**

12:00 NOON – Leadline – Open to riders 6 years of age and younger, led by an adult.

BEGINNER EQUITATION: Open to riders who do not yet canter in a group. May not cross enter into Novice division.

2. Walk / Trot
3. Walk / Trot / Individual Canter

NOVICE EQUITATION: Open to riders who have never shown 2' or higher. May not cross enter into Beginner division, or any open divisions.

4. Walk / Trot
5. Walk / Trot / Canter
6. Over Crossrails

BEGINNER/NOVICE PLEASURE: To be judged on manners and suitability as a pleasure mount. May not cross enter into Open or Hopeful Divisions.

7. Walk / Trot
8. Walk / GAYP
9. Walk / Trot / Canter

OPEN PLEASURE JUNIOR RIDERS: To be judged on manners and suitability as a pleasure mount. Open to riders 18 and under, mounted on horses or ponies.

10. Walk / Trot
11. Walk / GAYP
12. Walk / Trot / Canter

OPEN PLEASURE ADULT RIDERS: Same as Junior Pleasure, but open to adults on horses or ponies.

13. Walk / Trot
14. Walk / GAYP
15. Walk / Trot / Canter

16. MODEL CLASS – JUNE SHOW

ONLY: Open to horses and ponies, shown in a bridle, to be judged on conformation, movement and soundness.

INTERMEDIATE HUNTER: Open to horses or riders (but not together, please!) who do not yet show higher than 2'. May cross enter into Open Equitation.

OPEN EQUITATION: Judged on rider's position, control and technique. Fences 2'.

HOPEFUL HUNTER: Open to horses or ponies. Fences 2'3" or 2'6". May split according to height if entries warrant.

26. HANDY HUNTER: Offered at 2'3" and 2'6". Judged on versatility and handiness. May be asked to trot, hand gallop, halt or perform other tests.
